Meeting opened 7:00 p.m. October 10th minutes approved

Athletics: Fall sports are over for now with strong finishes in all. Steve Harms expressed gratitude for the influence the programs have on the whole school year. Winter programs begin next Monday including the first BVNW girls' bowling team. Husky Dare to Care and Husky Night will be Nov. 30th at 6 and 7 p.m. Steve reminded us to notice new banners outside the school. He also shared that the new anti-drinking video was shown to the entire school through the advisory hour.

Activities : Teresa Potts thanked PBC for the meal on conference night which also provided many with lunch the next day. Fall plays were well attended. Auditions for South Pacific, NHS induction, the Dazzler fund-raiser and a Thanksgiving meal prepared by FOCUS students are underway. This week is a school-wide Dodge Ball Tournament. She also reminded us to enjoy the senior class gift from last year, an outside reflection area which turned out to be quite lovely. Dec. 2nd begins winter activities with a Band concert Dec. 6th. The band GLOW SHOW delighted a record crowd this year--at least 1256 tickets sold. Next year concessions will be offered at the event.

Officer Reports: . Jeanna Repass mentioned the open houses at BV CAPS program which occur every two weeks. She reported on the upcoming bond issue election which, if passed, will be used to aid building facilities and technology. Information will be sent to all patrons in the district in early 2012 and community informational meetings will be held to communicate the process and reason for the bonds. Jennifer and Stephanie reminded board of the upcoming staff luncheon on Dec. 1st. at 11:30 a.m. Treasurer's report accepted. No secretary report.

SPENDING REQUESTS: After review and discussion, two of the fall spending requests were deferred: the recycling containers for Kay Club (waiting on additional information about required recycling changes that go into effect in January) and the second backstop screen for baseball. B. **All School Fund-Raiser :** Teresa Curtis reported on-line reservations are a bit over 300 which is smaller than last year's 400. Typically about 420 people attend the event but we do not expect to match that number this year. Donated items are on pace with previous years. Usually about 160 people actually purchase things. Anna Randazzo reports on needing more volunteers, especially students. Jeanna Repass thanks the committee for amazing work on much shorter time frame this year.
